

ORDINANCE NO. 2015- 16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CLYDE FOR PLANNING, DESIGN AND/OR CONSTRUCTION OF WASTEWATER FACILITIES; AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Clyde seek to upgrade its existing wastewater facilities;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Clyde intends to apply for Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for the planning, design and or construction of the wastewater facilities;
and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF loan, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for planning, design and/or construction of wastewater facilities on behalf of the City of Clyde, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the dedicated source of repayment will be the City of Clyde Sewer Fund.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the City of Clyde and for further reason that the immediate passage of this legislation is needed to meet the construction deadline as established by the 2004 USEPA Consent Decree, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
