

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 34

A RESOLUTION RENAMING CHERRY STREET PARK TO THADDEUS HURD PARK IN THE CITY OF CLYDE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Thaddeus B. Hurd was born in Clyde, Ohio, October 23, 1903, graduated from Clyde High School in 1920 at the top of his class; and

WHEREAS, Thaddeus B. Hurd organized Clyde (Ohio) Heritage League in 1975 and the Clyde Senior Center in 1980. He was instrumental in reactivating the Sandusky County Historical Society in 1957 and in 1967 organized the genealogical division. Mr. Hurd held memberships in the Ohio Association of Historical Societies and Museums, Firelands Historical Society, Mad River and NKP Railroad Society, Mayflower Descendants, the Society for the Study of Midwestern Literature, and the Sherwood Anderson Society. In addition, he served as Historian of Clyde, Ohio, of General James B. McPherson and of Sherwood Anderson's Ohio years; and

WHEREAS, Clyde City Council passed Resolution No. 2015-32 on July 7, 2015 to support the efforts of the Sherwood Anderson Society of Clyde, Ohio related to the re-establishment of Sherwood Anderson Park, the establishment of Thaddeus Hurd Park, signs for the proposed Sherwood Anderson and Thaddeus Hurd parks and the replacement of deteriorated or non-existent signs in all other parks in the City of Clyde.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Clyde hereby officially renames Cherry Street Park located on Cherry Street in the City of Clyde as Thaddeus Hurd Park in honor of Mr. Hurd's numerous contributions as a historian of the City of Clyde.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to cause the above name change to be reflected on all official maps and a new park sign be constructed and erected.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in effect and full force on and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by law.
