

RESOLUTION NO. 2015- 50

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF WSOS COMMUNITY ACTION COMMISSION TO MAINTAIN SERVICES FOR SENIOR PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, WSOS Community Action Commission has been managing programs that serve senior citizens of Sandusky County since 1974; and

WHEREAS, WSOS Senior Programs in 2014 accomplished the following in Sandusky County:

- Served 76,000 meals to seniors;
- Transported 185 seniors on over 2,800 trips to dentist, doctor, other medical, grocery stores, banking or other essential errands;
- Provided 94 educational programs for seniors;
- Provided 1029 socialization activities for senior participants;
- Coordinated 801 health assessments; and

WHEREAS, the WSOS Senior Programs has been providing services in Clyde since 1978; and

WHEREAS, WSOS Senior Programs in 2014 accomplished the following in Clyde and surrounding areas:

- Provided 15,811 meals to homebound seniors ;
- Provided 3,521 meals to seniors at the center;
- Provided educational, socialization and health assessments to seniors at the senior center; and

WHEREAS, Senior Programs assisted more than 2,452 seniors in Sandusky County last year by leveraging federal, state, local, and private resources, including more than 6,174 volunteer hours; and

WHEREAS, the need for senior meal services in Sandusky County has grown and the population in Sandusky County of those over 75 years of age will continue to grow over the next five years at the same pace it has during the last five years; and this is the target group that receives home delivered meals; and


WHEREAS, WSOS has a proven commitment to providing nutritious meals to the homebound, hot lunches daily at senior centers, transportation for medical services and many other education and social activities to help local seniors maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Clyde Council, does hereby proclaim our support for Senior Services and urge all citizens to take this opportunity to recognize the need to maintain services by voting for the senior levy on the ballot in November.
