**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
AN AGREEMENT WITH THE JEFFERSON HEALTH PLAN FOR
THE FURNISHING AND ADMINISTRATION OF
EMPLOYEE HEALTHCARE BENEFITS**

WHEREAS, the City of Clyde has been a member of and utilized the services of the Buckeye Ohio Risk Management Association (BORMA) for the furnishing and administration of employee healthcare benefits for at least the last 12 years, and

WHEREAS, the city will not renew a new three year term with BORMA beginning January 1, 2016.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City of Clyde shall join and become a member of The Jefferson Health Plan beginning January 1, 2016 renewing annually thereafter. The City of Clyde understands that, as a member of The Jefferson Health Plan, it will have access to all programs, services, and benefits that are available to other members under the current governing documents of The Jefferson Health Plan.

SECTION 2. That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept and sign the member agreement of The Jefferson Health Plan.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
