

ORDINANCE NO. 2016- 05

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF UP TO FORTY (40) SETS OF STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTING TURN-OUT GEAR, AS APPROVED FOR THE PURCHASE BY THE AFG AWARD FROM FEMA, FOR THE CLYDE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE CITY OF CLYDE, OHIO; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR SAME; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise and receive bids according to Section 133.01 (a) and 133.01 (b) et seq. of the Clyde Code of Ordinances for the purchase and delivery of up to forty (40) sets of structural firefighting turn-out gear, as approved for the purchase, by the AFG Award from FEMA for the Clyde Fire Department in the City of Clyde, and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder thereof, after prior consultation with and approval of this Council.

SECTION 2. That the expenditure of funds for such purpose is hereby authorized and shall be taken from the General Fund.

SECTION 3. That specifications for the above items and other bidder information shall be placed on file in the Office of the City Manager to enable prospective bidders to examine.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the City of Clyde, Ohio, and for further reason to expedite the bidding process in order to replace noncompliant gear, wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
