

ORDINANCE NO. 2016- 11

**AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A CITY SOLICITOR AND ESTABLISHING THE DUTIES AND SALARY OF SAME; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Attorney Zachary Selvey of Clyde, Ohio, be and he/she is hereby appointed as Solicitor for the City of Clyde, effective February 15th, 2016 for an indefinite term in accordance with Section 6-7, City of Clyde Charter.

**SECTION 2.** That the salary of the City Solicitor is hereby established at One Thousand One Hundred and Fourteen Dollars and No Cents (\$1,114.00) bi-weekly. Ordinance No. 2014-69 does not apply as it relates to benefits for full-time administrative personnel.

**SECTION 3.** That the above salary shall be considered compensation for normal Solicitor's duties and attendance at all Council meetings and preparation therefor; for the preparation of all normal and usual ordinances and resolutions; and in the capacity as legal advisor for all officers and boards and commissions of the City of Clyde and that the above salary rate shall apply only so long as the City Solicitor is also employed as a part time prosecutor at the Sandusky County Prosecutor's office.

**SECTION 4.** For any additional services performed for special legislation to include such matters as bond issues, annexation, prosecution and defense of actions by or against the municipality, land acquisitions, or other projects of large or unusual nature, the Solicitor shall be compensated upon a per diem basis at his customary hourly rate when requested to perform such services by the municipality of Clyde, Ohio. Invoices for such services shall be submitted to the municipality on or about January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1 of each year.


**SECTION 5.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the City of Clyde, Ohio, and for further reason that the immediate appointment of a Solicitor is necessary for the continued and efficient operation of municipal functions, wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
