A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH 7L CONSTRUCTION, LLC. FOR ASPHALT PAVING AT THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN CITY OF CLYDE; APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF MONEYS THEREFOR.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with 7L Construction, LLC., 553 Southwest Street, P.O. Box 326, Bellevue, OH 44811 for Asphalt Paving at the Waste Water Treatment Plant in the City of Clyde for the amount of \$38,900.00 as per the attached proposal dated May 23, 2016.

SECTION 2. That funds in the amount of Thirty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$38,900.00) shall be appropriated from the Sewer Fund and the expenditure of funds in such amount is expressly authorized.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is further authorized by this Council to execute any and all documents associated with this project, including Change Orders; Additional Work Orders by either Unit Pricing or agreed upon pricing by the City and the Contractor performing the work.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
