

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-43

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT VENDORS (PEDDLERS) SELLING FOOD, BEVERAGES, GOODS, MERCHANDISE OR PRODUCT WARES WITHIN A DESIGNATED AREA DURING THE DATES OF THE CLYDE FAIR BE APPROVED BY THE FAIR BOARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the CITY of CLYDE holds a fair each September that is regulated and promoted by The Fair Board, which is, in turn, empowered through City Council.

WHEREAS, in order to fairly and adequately regulate vendors and or peddlers during the dates of the fair this ordinance shall be put in place to allow The Fair Board to create a fair business environment for participating vendors and peddlers.

WHEREAS, all vendors and or peddlers selling food, beverages, goods, merchandise, and or product wares within the designated area described below during the dates of the Clyde Fair must be approved by The Fair Board.

WHEREAS, the designated area falling under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be the entire area contained within the following described boundary:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Forest Street and centerline of Church Street, the POINT OF BEGINNING

Thence continuing Northerly along the center line of Church Street to the intersection of the centerline of Church Street and the centerline of the Norfolk Southern Railroad;

Thence continuing Westerly along the centerline of the Norfolk Southern Railroad to the intersection of the centerline of the Norfolk Southern Railroad and the centerline of George Street;

Thence continuing Southerly along the centerline of George Street to the intersection of the centerline of George Street with the centerline of Forest Street;

Thence continuing Easterly along the centerline of Forest Street to the intersection of the centerline of Forest Street and centerline of Church Street, the POINT OF BEGINNING.

WHEREAS, a first time violation of this Ordinance shall be a Minor Misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) and a second violation of this Ordinance shall be a Misdemeanor of the Fourth Degree punishable by up to 30 days in jail and a fine of up to Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

BE IT ORDANED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. This ordinance is intended for transient venders (peddlers) only and will not affect local established businesses, restaurants, and or bars from selling their products and wares as intended by current laws and regulations in place.



That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the City of Clyde, Ohio and for further reason, to complete the ordinance within the 2016 Clyde City Fair season, wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
