

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BUSINESSES ENGAGED IN THE LEGAL SALE AND OR CULTIVATION OF MARIJUANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the State of Ohio has recently passed legislation whereby certain sales and uses of Marijuana will be deemed legal in the near future.

SECTION 2. That the City Council wishes to regulate the sale and or cultivation of Marijuana within the City of Clyde due to fears relating to the overwhelming number of drug related deaths in Clyde in the recent past.

SECTION 3. That any business wishing to engage in the cultivation and or sale of marijuana or any products containing marijuana must be approved by BOTH the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) AND then also by City Council at Council's next regularly scheduled meeting following BZA approval.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by law.
