

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-10

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SANDUSKY COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE 0.55 MILL LEVY.

WHEREAS, this Council recognizes the imminent danger to the health and safety of the community, most specifically our children and young people, that the distribution of illegal substance poses; and

WHEREAS, it is further recognized that the use of a County-wide Drug Task Force comprised of undercover police personnel and personnel from the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney can be an effective means of apprehending, and removing from the community, individuals involved in criminal drug activity; and

WHEREAS, such a County-wide Drug Task Force is a specialized unit created for a specific purpose and function, not entirely provided for within the structure of the Clyde Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Article XII, of the Ohio Constitution provides that the ten (10) mill limitation on property taxes therein imposed may be altered by a vote of the majority of the qualified electors of the county; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the City of Clyde to permit the electorate of the County to express its view on the question of a levy in the amount of 0.55 mills to be used to fund the County-wide Drug Task Force (DTF) in Sandusky County, Ohio.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Clyde, Sandusky County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Clyde hereby supports the Commissioners of Sandusky County, Ohio in placing on the ballot, a proposition for a 0.55 mill levy, renewable every five years, to be used solely for funding the operation of a County-wide Drug Task Force (DTF), under the administration of the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of Sandusky County.


SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.
