

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-31

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE CLYDE LIGHT & POWER WEST SUBSTATION ELECTRICAL STATION UPGRADES TO JCN POWER SERVICES, LLC OF LEESBURG, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Clyde City Council on August 2, 2016 did pass Emergency Ordinance No. 2016-40, authorizing the bidding for West Substation Electrical Station Upgrades at Clyde Light & Power in the City of Clyde, and

WHEREAS, said legal notice was advertised in a newspaper of general circulation, and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened for said West Substation Electrical Station Upgrades on April 28, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Clyde, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Clyde City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to award the bid for the West Substation Electrical Station Upgrades to **JCN Power Services, LLC of 9706 Grimsley Rd., Leesburg, OH 45135 for the bid amount of Three Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety Dollars and Zero Cents (\$373,390.00).**

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is further authorized by this Council to execute any and all documents associated with this project, including Change Orders; Additional Work Orders by either Unit Pricing or agreed upon pricing by the City and the Contractor performing the work.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.

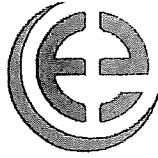

Subject: Award – West Substation – Electrical Station Upgrades

Bids were received April 28th, 2017, 10:00 am for the West Substation – Electrical Station Upgrades. Bids were received from the companies below for the following amounts:

	<u>Base Bid</u>
1. JCN Power Services, LLC:	\$373,390.00
2. Vaughn Industries:	\$392,209.58

Of the two (2) bids received, both bidders provided complete bid packages in response to all six (6) requested bid sub-items, forms and certificates. Vaughn however did not acknowledge receipt of Addendum No. 1, but had access to the documents including the addendum through our electronic bulletin board service. Addendum No. 1 simply published the Engineer's Estimate and did not contain any changes, additions or deletions to the scope of work being bid by Contractors. In addition, Vaughn Industries did not include constructing a temporary pole to feed Whirlpool during the construction period and included Time and Material rates instead. JCN Power Services submitted the lowest bid and did not take any exception to the bidding specifications.

In summary, it is recommended that Bid Item No. 1 is awarded to the best lowest, responsive bidder, which is JCN Power Services in this case. Please proceed with the award of this bid to JCN Power Services, LLC in the amount of \$373,390.00.
