

RESOLUTION 2017 - 35

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT FEES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Clyde desires to establish fair and equitable policies and procedures to collect said charges; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has further determined that the Ohio Attorney General's Office provides this means of collecting outstanding debt at no cost to the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the Attorney General's Office has a long track record of successful collection of delinquent debt throughout the State of Ohio

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council for the City of Clyde, Sandusky County, Ohio as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to contract with the Ohio Attorney General's office, Collections Enforcement Section, for delinquent municipal income taxes or other eligible fees and charges.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall take affect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
