

## **Administrative Report for April 18, 2017**

Construction season has finally arrived and I couldn't be happier. We have a very ambitious summer scheduled. By Department.....

GENERAL SERVICES - prep. work for the 2017 Paving Program

- Elmdale/Midvale Storm Sewer Phases III and IV
- Culvert and ditch work on Elm Street

ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES - new water main on East Cherry Street

- assist with Hammer Street Improvement
- prep. work for paving at Hurd Park

CLYDE LIGHT & POWER - Phase II of city-wide LED street light conversion

- Decorative Light Replacement on Main Street
- assist with West Sub-station Improvements

PARKS - prep work for 2017 Paving Program

- Erection of new small shelter house in lower-lot
- assist with new "soft-surface" for kids toys at Aquatic Center

Last Monday, April 10th I met with ODOT District 2 officials to discuss numerous items related to the city. First, we discussed and submitted our recently completed US RT 20 Speed Study. As you might remember, Richland Engineering was hired to conduct this study which must then be reviewed and approved by ODOT prior to any non-statutory speed limits being journalized. ODOT could not commit to a completion date for their review. Next, we discussed our recently submitted Small City Grant and I pushed for District 2 support at the state level. Our grant application includes sewer separation work on US RT 20 and a complete rebuild of SR 101 from US RT 20 to the railroad spur. Finally, we discussed the "closing-out" of the US RT Culvert by Hall's Market. There was a substantial under-run on this project due to the non-performance of numerous items. This in turn, should create a refund for the city.
