



EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2016

Yard waste (grass, weeds, etc.) will be collected by a vacuum machine **the first full week and third week of every month on your day of pick up**. It is important that all yard waste be placed to the curb so the vacuum can collect them. Yard waste must be free of trash and other yard debris such as tree limbs and rocks. Tree limbs and other yard debris can clog and damage the machine. **The machine is designed to vacuum YARD WASTE ONLY!**

If you have brush to be picked up, please place it in a separate pile away from the yard waste piles.

COLLECTION TIPS

- Place yard waste (grass, weeds, etc) into a long pile along the curb. Please **DO NOT** bag yard waste they will be left. Yard waste must be loose so the machine can pick them up.
- Be sure yard waste piles are separate from other yard debris and trash.
- Avoid piling yard waste in front of mailboxes, utility poles, trees and guide wires.
- **DO NOT** pile yard waste on top of storm drains or into the street. Storm drains can become clogged and cause flooding.
- Residents are asked to restrain from parking on streets in front of or near piles so we can access piles.
- Please keep in mind this is a new system and we may be delayed by the weather, quantity of yard waste or equipment failure.
