Main Street to Downtown - Lighted Floats are Highly Encouraged

Lineup will be at Harvest Baptist Temple at 5:00 pm. Parade begins at 6:00 pm.

The parade route begins at Harvest Baptist Temple, located at 1022 S. Main Street, Clyde OH 43410 and follows Main Street north through the downtown area, stopping at the intersection of Main Street, and Maple Street where the tree is lit.

Prizes will be awarded based on originality, adherence to theme, and creativity. The decision of the judges is final.

Parade Rules:

- All Units must Register
- Units are not allowed to stop procession of the parade; exception being emergencies only. Floats may not stop at the Judge's Stand, or risk disqualification
- In case of emergency, units will be directed to side of parade route. Please respect the request, and respond in an urgent and cooperative manner
- Unit(s), organization(s) or individual(s) which disrespect or disloyal to the American flag, Community, or Country, or use any emblem or subject deemed contrary to good taste will be removed from the parade and / or area by a parade representative or law enforcement official
- Height requirement for entries is 14 feet, maximum
- No one is permitted to ride on the hood of a vehicle
- No throwing items from floats, cars, trucks or other units. You must walk curbside of street to pass out candy, literature or other hand-outs
- Drivers of any vehicle entered in the parade must be 18, have a legal driver's license and carry liability auto insurance. Entry organizers are responsible for verification for their group members
- There is no alternate rain date for this parade. The parade may be cancelled if necessary, due to inclement weather
